In the 1980s, a few MIT faculty members with manufacturing contacts saw an opportunity to develop a set of courses where they could mix the theory and practice of manufacturing together. With the help of Hill-Rom, and other manufacturing companies, the IPC's equipment and material was donated. The institute opened in 1988 with 10 students. Today the IPC is the largest industrial design/manufacturing program in the world with over 80 students, over 80% of which are women. More than 90% of the IPC industrial design/manufacturing faculty are based in the United States. The IPC offers a comprehensive four-year industrial design/manufacturing program, including a two-year business foundation, which is required for all students. The IPC provides a robust curriculum of courses in the area of design, production, management, and technology, including: An introductory course in design and production, focused on the technical, economic, and environmental factors of manufacturing. A course of study in design, production, and management; these courses lead to a Certificate in Contemporary Industry. Plasma concentrations of endogenous insulin were studied in normal and diabetic patients, as well as in patients with different degrees of glycemic control, by radioimmunoassay. Unmedicated diabetics had a high level of insulin (22 +/- 2.8 pmol/l) that was not significantly different from that of normal subjects (24 +/- 1.8 pmol/l). Diabetic patients treated with anti-diabetic medications showed a reduced plasma insulin level (16.3 +/- 3.9 pmol/l) and were also found to have a significantly higher glucose concentration when compared to normal patients (p less than 0.01). This was also true of the patients studied while fasting and after a glucose load. These data indicate that the ability of diabetic patients to produce insulin is not altered in the fasting state, as such, the failure of insulin secretion by diabetic patients becomes more apparent with a glucose load.
